- Activities:
- coloring page (included in your packet)
 - Tumbletunes to sing along with: "Wash Your Hands" and "Till the Virus Ends".
 - since Felicity saw a tiger, search the Tumblebooks videos for the National Geographic clip about "Siberian Tigers".

Tuesday, June 2 - *When Turtle Grew Feathers*

- This book is a Choctaw variation of Aesop's fable, "The Tortoise and the Hare".

- Activity:
Make a tortoise with a paper plate, the paper cutouts included in your kit, and a few of your own supplies (scissors, glue, crayons or paint)



Wednesday, June 3 - Online Program: Southeastern Indians

Thursday, June 4 - *Burro's Tortillas*

- This book is a new take on "The Little Red Hen" folktale.
 - A.R. level 3.0
 - Available on Tumblebooks
- Activities:
- Character stick puppets: Included in your bag, you will find a coloring page with Burro and two of his friends. Color them, cut them out, and tape or glue them to the enclosed popsicle sticks. Use these stick puppets to retell the story you just read.
 - sequencing activity in your bag: Follow the directions on the printed sheet to make an instruction page about how to make tortillas like Burro did in our story. There are snack suggestions on the printed sheet, too.

Friday, June 5 - *The Little Red Hen/La Gallinita Roja*

- Who doesn't love the folktale "The Little Red Hen"? This bilingual version by Carol Ottolenghi, part of the Bilingual Fairy Tales series, gives you a chance to hear some Spanish words as you read along.

- Activities:
- In your bag, you will find a recipe for homemade rolls, so you can try to bake bread like the hen in the story. Be sure you have a grown-up's help
 - There's also a piece of green paper and a page of cutouts. Simply color, cut and glue the page of cutouts to make a hen picture that matches the example printed next to your recipe.
