

Pete's Shoe Tying & Lacing Practice

You will need:

- Mod-Podge or School Glue
- Thin cardboard
- Scissors
- Single hole-punch
- Spare shoe laces
- Crayons/Markers
- Tape

1. Cut along the dotted line to remove the directions. *Be sure to get a grown-up to help with cutting and glue!*
2. Glue the whole square with the shoes to some thin cardboard (like a used cereal box).
3. After the glue is dry, color the shoes.
4. Cut off the extra paper/cardboard around each shoe and use a single hole punch to punch holes where the laces will go.
5. Now you can practice tying or lacing your shoes! (Tape the shoes to a table to keep them still when you tie.)
