## Big Kid Book Rec Book Recommendation for grades 3 - 6

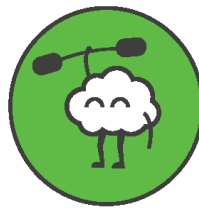
*Buster* by Caleb Zane Huett

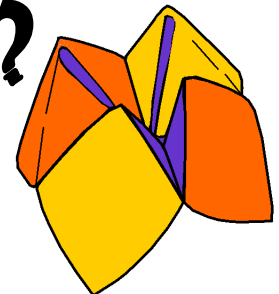
