When accessing these newspapers from home, you will be required to log in. Unless otherwise noted, your log-in information is your DPL card number. If a PIN is required, it will be the last four digits of your DPL card number.



DPL offers has a subscription to the digital newspaper collection from NewsBank. It is a fully searchable collection which provides online access to electronic editions of local, state & national newspapers. It is updated daily.

Decatur Daily Collection

Decatur Daily issues in electronic form from 2004 to **current**. Find full-text articles on local news, **issues**, events, people and much more. Updated daily, it includes obituaries, editorials, announcements, sports, real estate and other sections. Best of all, you can search by key word or name.

Alabama News Sources

Search current and archived newspapers from around the state that feature image editions, which allow you to search or browse replicas of popular newspapers' print editions online, with full-color layouts of all news articles, graphics, advertisements, classifieds, weather reports, box scores, puzzles, cartoons and more. CREATING YOUR NEWSPAPERARCHIVE® ACCOUNT
