Book Babies

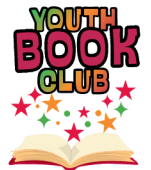

LEGO® Programs

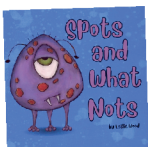
At **LEGO® Morning**, we'll have our LEGO® bricks out in the *Youth Services Room* for kids of all ages to stop by and create a masterpiece.
