Book Babies

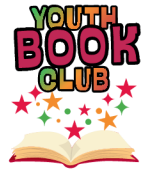
In this story time for babies from birth to 3 years old, we sing songs, do bouncing rhymes, and read books to encourage early literacy.

Meets in the Story Hour Room.

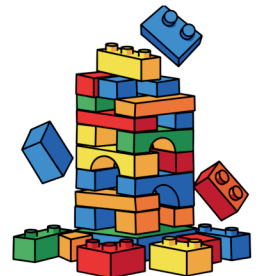


Saturday Story Time is designed for school-aged kids. We will read a couple of stories to go along with the theme, say poems, and have an activity. This month's theme is Halloween.
